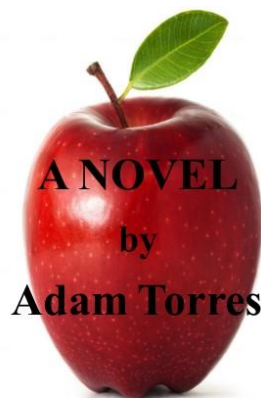
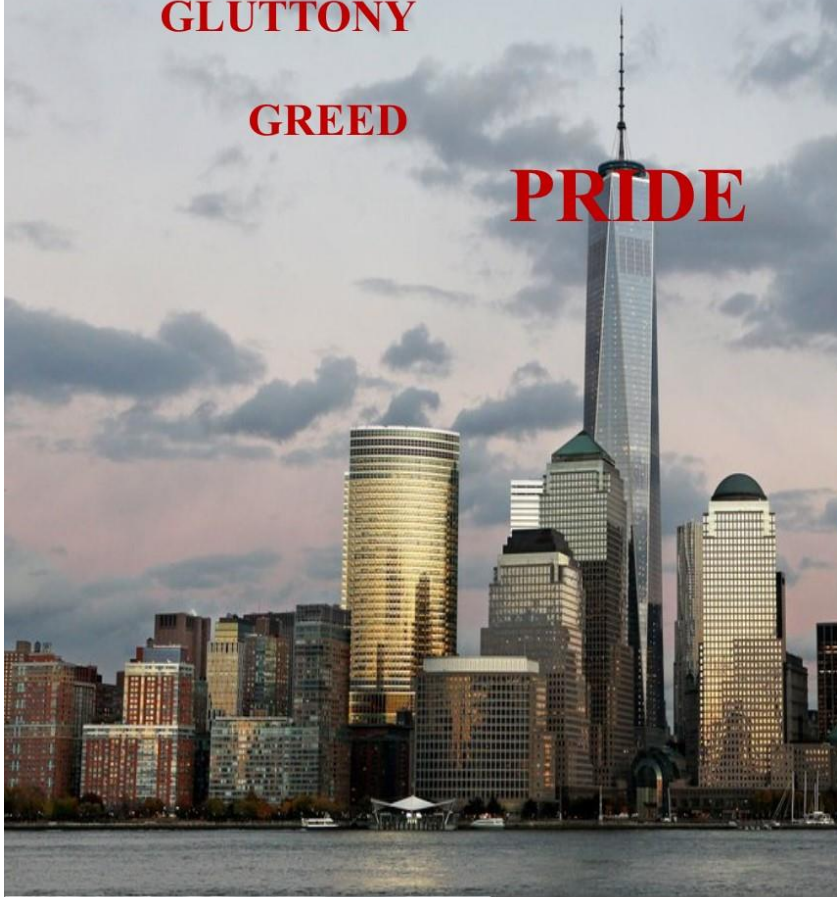

## Preface
